### **Health Requirements:**

Horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by the following documentation:

**Current Vaccines:** Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) Vaccinations within six months prior to entering the show grounds.

**Coggins Test:** Texas State law requires that each horse be accompanied by a negative EIA Certificate dated within one year.

**Health Certificate:** A Health certificate dated within 21 days of arrival to be presented when entering the show grounds.

**Entry blanks must be signed before you can school your horse.**

## COVID -19 HEALTH & SAFETY PRACTICES

In order to ensure everyone's safety at the show, we ask that the following protocol is followed.

**ENTRIES** : Enter on line at [www.horseshowsonline](http://www.horseshowsonline) Paper entries will not be accepted.

**SHOW OFFICE:** Trainer packets will be available for check out. Barns are required to check in / check out with one representative handling barn account.

**HEALTH PAPERS:** All horse health papers must be emailed to [Checkin@gswe.com](mailto:Checkin@gswe.com)

**HAY AND FEED ORDERS:** Pre Orders must be filled out on the reservation form prior to the start of the show. After the start of the show, all hay and feed can be ordered via txt at (210)870-4584.

**ADDS/SCRATCHES:** Adds and scratches must be done through horseshowsonline the day before showing. Time permitting, daily adds and scratches can be made at the ingate of each show ring.

**EXHIBITORS/TRAINERS/GROOMS/OTHERS:** While on the show grounds it is a requirement to wear a cloth mouth and face cover at all times unless mounted. Use sanitizing stations located around the facility to sanitize your hands often. Avoid close contact – stay a safe distance of 6 feet apart, practice social distancing. Bring your own chair for watching at the show rings. One person per golf cart unless you are from the same household. Please do not loiter on property when you are done showing to keep the number of people on site to a minimum. Trainers will be responsible for the conduct of their clients and staff. If you do not follow the rules of conduct you will be asked to leave without refund.

**BARNS/STABLE AREA :** Limit gatherings in the barn aisles and stabling area. No chairs or seating in the main walkway, stall fronts or barn aisles will be permitted. Leave an empty stall at the front of your aisle to provide space. Only people affiliated with the barn will be permitted in the barn aisle.

**WASH RACKS/RESTROOMS:** Wash racks will be limited to two people at time. Do NOT leave wash buckets in wash racks. Practice social distancing in the wash racks and restrooms.

**HORSE SHOW ISSUED NUMBERS must be worn in the competition rings.**

**Protective headgear is required for ALL riders while mounted on horses on the horse show ground in accordance with USEF rules. The USEF rule also applies to adults where jumping and when jumping is required (schooling and warm-up rings).**

**WARNING:** Under Texas Law (Chapter 87, Civil, Practice and Remedies Code), a farm animal professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in farm animal activities resulting from the inherent risks of farm animal activities.

All minors must have parent/trainer or guardian sign an entry release. In all classes except for warm-up classes, riders must wear shirts with collars and either boots and breeches or paddock boots and jodhpurs in order to show. All riders and trainers of entries in this show must be members in good standing of GHHJA, or pay non-member fees. Horses and ponies competing for year-end awards must be registered, and their owners and trainers must be members. Membership dues are \$275 for lifetime membership, \$45 annual for seniors (age 18 & over), \$40 annual for juniors (under age 18), Owner/Parent/Other annual \$35 and horse/pony registration is \$45 (lifetime) or \$15 (annual). Dues must be paid to show secretary or proof of membership and horse/pony registration must be submitted before showing. **A non-member rider or non-member trainer may participate after paying the show secretary a “non-member fee” of \$12.00 per show day.** Lead line participants are exempt from non-member fees. \*Duplicate horse/pony names are not allowed. The owner must first check the current registration list to avoid name duplication.

Management reserves the right to change, cancel, or combine classes or to do anything necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. GREAT SOUTHWEST EQUESTRIAN CENTER L.P., Amy Uniss, Val Garza, or GHHJA and/or the show management or employees is not responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any persons, horses or property.
